ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. PRE-DEPARTURE

To protect the Galapagos' ecosystem, guests aged 18 and above are required to complete an online [Declaration Form](#) up to 48 hours prior to their trip.

Travelers to the Galapagos Islands must book round-trip flight tickets and present them at the Quito or Guayaquil airport prior to departure.

2. TRANSIT CONTROL CARD

A Transit Control Card (TCC or TCT) is required for entering and exiting the Galápagos Islands and will be arranged by Aqua Expeditions. For guests not traveling on our recommended flights or those arriving in Galápagos before embarkation day and therefore not requiring our airport dispatch service, will receive their TCC digitally 24 hours before their flight.

Alternatively, for guests traveling on our recommended LATAM flights, our airport representative in Quito or Guayaquil will provide the TCC in printed format during the dispatch process.

If the guest prefers to receive the TCC digitally instead, this can be arranged in advance prior to their flight. Guests will need to keep this card until the end of their journey and must be presented to airport authorities upon final departure from the islands.

3. BOARDING

As per Ecuador's biosecurity protocols, all luggage will be screened before guests are allowed to board the flight. This is to ensure that no new species — plants, seeds, or live animals — are introduced to the islands' ecosystem.

4. ENTRY FEE

Upon arrival at Seymour Airport on Baltra Island, an entry fee will be levied. For foreign tourists above the age of 12, the fee is USD 200, while those under the age of 12 are charged USD 100. Citizens of the Andean Community (CAN) and Mercosur are charged USD 100.

These funds are used by the Galapagos National Park to finance the conservation of the islands' biodiversity and improve the standard of living of the local community.

Aqua Expeditions will prepay this entry fee for all Aqua Mare guests.

5. ARRIVAL

Guests should head directly to the VIP lounge (to the right of Immigration Control) where Aqua representatives will assist guests with the Baggage and Customs procedures—which may take up to an hour. Thereafter, guests will be escorted on a shared transfer to Aqua Mare, where our crew will be on hand to assist with luggage retrieval.
